CONDITIONS AND UNDERTAKING BY THE CANDIDATE AND BY THE PARENT

- 1. At the time of admission to the degree course / programme, original certificates should be submitted to the Administrative office for verification.
- 2. One set of attested copy of all the original certificates should also be submitted to the Administrative office.
- 3. Incomplete Application forms will be automatically rejected. Students must pay the tuition fee, hostel fee and other fee on time. Students are eligible to sit in the class for the semester / year only after making payments of tuition fee and other fee in the beginning of academic year / semester.
- 4. The name of the students who have failed to remit their tuition fee within 15 days from the commencement of the academic session will be removed from the attendance rolls.
